Memory Clinic Process

You will be seen by an experienced team of memory nurses and consultant psychiatrists.

The assessment takes place in the following stages:



Stage 1

One of our memory clinic nurses will do a brief assessment and undertake an ACE III memory test.





Stage 2

Our nurse will forward the information to the consultant, who will recommend relevant blood tests and head scans, which will be undertaken in your local community hospital setting.





Stage 3

You will be seen by one of our consultant psychiatrists who will undertake a thorough assessment and discuss the outcome of all your tests, leading to a diagnosis, where appropriate.





Stage 4

A comprehensive report will be sent to your local memory service who will arrange all follow up and action any recommendations.

How the assessment is done



Stages 1 and 3 of the assessment will take place online, using a device such as a desktop computer, laptop, iPad or other tablet.



These can be organised in the comfort of your home, a care home, a hospital, or your local NHS trust..



We ask for a family member, staff member or nurse who knows you well to be present with you for the duration of the assessment.

They will form an essential part of the information gathering process.
